

## Prepare for Refinishing

- There needs to be running water and electricity on the day of the refinishing
- Any leaking plumbing will need to be repaired prior to the project date, as this
  can damage the final result. We recommend hiring a licensed plumber to perform
  this.
- We recommend that faucets, valves, trim, shower doors, etc. are removed prior to the project and be reinstalled 24-48 hours after the completion. We recommend hiring a licensed plumber to complete this.
- Everything needs to be removed from the bathroom or within 10-15 feet of the working area prior to the AAA Dura-Glaze Technicians arrival. This includes any countertop items, shampoo or soap bottles, towels, plungers, shower curtain, rugs, pictures, etc.
- Please remove any dust, hair, cobwebs, etc from the working area to ensure these particles don't get into the wet finish after completion
- Remove any soap scum, mildew and calcium build-up from the surfaces to be refinished
- Any painting should be done at least 30 days prior to the refinishing date, as tape may be applied to walls of the surrounding refinishing area as protection
- We recommend any grout area or damaged tiles to be repaired, replaced and regrouting complete prior to any refinishing. Refinishing does not fill in missing or weak grout areas and it does not repair damaged tiles.
- Any construction projects which create dust or debris should be completed prior to the refinishing date
- We are not responsible for pulling out, removing or relocating cabinets toilets, stoves, ovens, sinks, etc. nor will they be reinstalled
- Specialized high-powered exhaust fans will be placed in the nearest exterior
  window to remove as much odor as possible. Plan indoor activities accordingly
  as even low VOC, FDA and EPA products do have a slight odor to individuals.
  Everyone has a different sensitivity level, therefore we recommend making
  arrangements or have a back up plan to leave the premises during the period
  that the technician is working. If this is not possible, plan to confine children,
  people or pets to a more remote location of the house from the refinishing area.
- Make proper arrangements as there is a 24 hour dry time before using the refinished surfaces. We do offer a 4 hour dry time product for a small additional fee.
